Consideration has been given under the Immigration Rules Appendix FM paragraph R-LTRP.1.1 (a), (b) and (c) Requirements for limited leave to remain as a Partner.

We are satisfied from the information you have provided that you meet these requirements and you have been granted leave within the Immigration Rules under D-LTRP.1.2 of Appendix FM

What this means for you.

We have endorsed your biometric resident permit with limited leave to remain in the United Kingdom initially for 30 months.

In order to qualify for settlement you must have completed a continuous period of at least 60 months in the United Kingdom with limited leave granted because of your family life.

Providing you continue to meet the criteria as set out in the relevant legislation at the time of application, you should apply for further leave in the prescribed manner prior to the expiry of your current leave. Subject to meeting that criteria you will be given a further period of leave of 30 months.

Conditions attached to your stay in the UK.

The conditions attached to this period of stay in the United Kingdom permit you to work, the details can be found below. However, access to public funds is not permitted as explained below.

Employment

You may establish a business or take employment without the need to apply for a work permit.

Public Funds

Under the Immigration Rules you are not entitled to receive public funds to help meet your living and accommodation costs (or those of any dependants). In addition your sponsor is not entitled to claim or receive public funds on your behalf. The term "public funds" is defined in paragraph 6 of the Immigration Rules. The public funds which you are not allowed to claim for and receive are listed below:

- income-based jobseeker's allowance
- attendance allowance
- severe disablement allowance
- carer's allowance
- disability living allowance
- income support
